If you are interested in joining Wayzata Community Church, our next New Member Receiving Sunday will be at our Sunday morning services on Sunday, October 28!

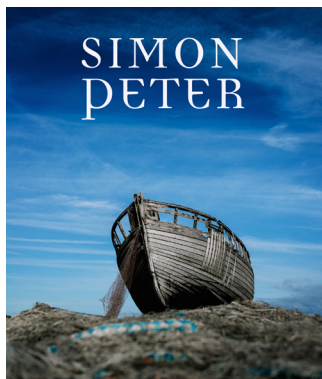
We invite you to our Fall New Member Orientations. Although these sessions are one

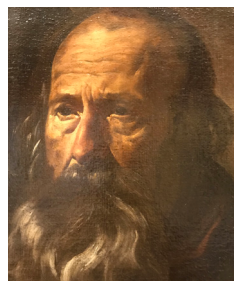
