If you are interested in joining Wayzata Community Church, our next New Member Sunday will be at our Sunday morning services on Sunday, October 28th!

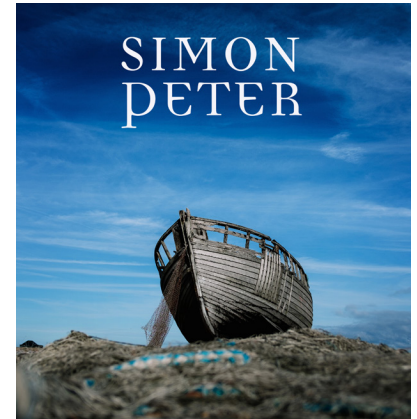

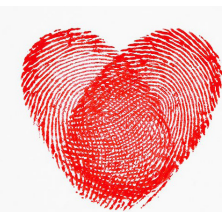
## SERMON NOTES

## FAMILIES MOVING FORWARD

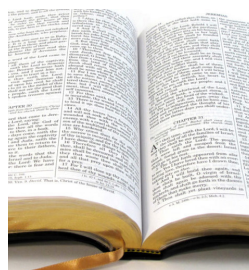
**Sunday, 10/21-Saturday, 10/28**
