Enneagram Know Your Number Workshop

September 20-21, 2019 As we Kick off our program year, don't miss this amazing event to start your school year. Know Your Number is a foundational course and is the first step in working with the Enneagram. In

this workshop, Master Enneagram Teacher Suzanne Stabile introduces the nine Enneagram Types. Each personality type is reviewed in detail, including an evaluation of the strengths and weaknesses of the Types, and the likely interpersonal challenges that may be involved in an unhealthy expression of the Type. This workshop is intended for those who want to discover their Enneagram number or are still unsure about their Enneagram number.
