As we Kick off our program year, don't miss this amazing event to start your school year. Know Your Number is a foundational course and is the first step in working with the Enneagram. In

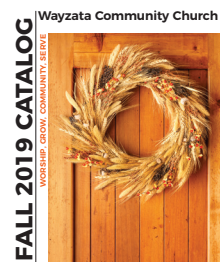
