JUNE 12: 2 GIRLS & A BOYD

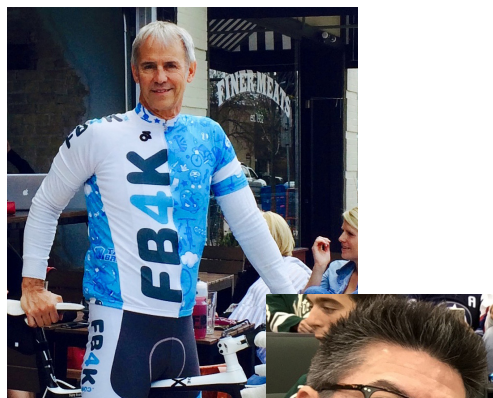

JUNE 19: NATE SABIN

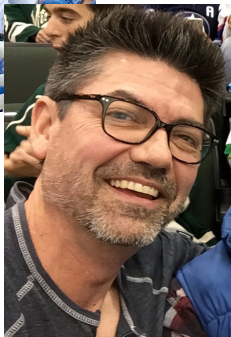

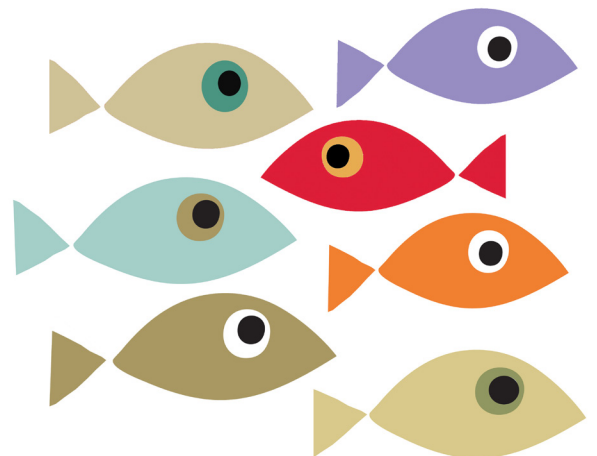
