The City of Plymouth offers Metrolink express buses to/from downtown Minneapolis and Dial-A-Ride services to local destinations. Dial-A-Ride is a curb-to-curb transit service for Plymouth residents and their guests. A mini-bus will take you anywhere in Plymouth and to these locations outside Plymouth: Ridgedale, downtown Wayzata, Golden Valley Center, and New Hope K-Mart. Dial-A-Ride is a shared ride service therefore travel may not always be direct to your destination. Services hours are Monday through Friday; 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. and fares are \$3 each way.

Weekday curb-to-curb service for the general public throughout the seven-county metropolitan area. It is a shared-ride service, which must be reserved in advance between two hours and five days in advance. Rides are subject to availability, and fares are based on distance traveled. The base fare is \$2.25, one way, for a trip up to 10 miles. Transit Link customers can transfer to a Metro Transit bus without paying a separate fare, just ask the driver for a paratransit transfer.

*Please note: Transit Link service is not available where regular transit routes are operating.*
