MUSIC NOTES (Autumn Toussaint, Director of Contemporary Music)

In 2008 when Pope Benedict XVI visited the United States, only one Artist was asked to lead Worship for a crowd of thousands at the Rally for Youth and Seminarians in Yonkers, New York, and it was Matt Maher. He is also one of the only Christian artists to have each of his albums break through the Billboard top 200 (the secular Billboard). Quite an accomplishment. Growing up Catholic, Matt learned the importance of prayer and rituals within his faith life. One of those was saying the Lord's Prayer dozens of times throughout the day. His family would often sing it as well. When Matt began writing songs, he was determined to come up with a new melody line for the Lord's Prayer that he could teach his own kids, alongside the standard. "As It Is In Heaven" was born. We hope singing this familiar prayer will leave the tune upon your heart, and perhaps help you find another way to incorporate it into your daily faith walk.

Our Scripture passage today describes a mountain top experience that reveals Jesus' true identity, an identity He has had since the beginning, but the Disciples are suddenly able to see Jesus' glory. The scene unfolds like a movie script with Moses and Elijah appearing, Jesus' clothes becoming dazzling white, a cloud that engulfs them, and the voice of God! What a moment that must have been, a Holy moment when Heaven and Earth became one. Our Anthem, "Here In Your Presence" speaks of those moments in our lives when we are amazed and speechless. Whether they are physical places or actual moments when you witness or feel something, we know we are standing on Holy Ground. Thin veil indeed.
