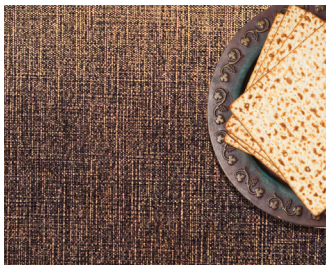

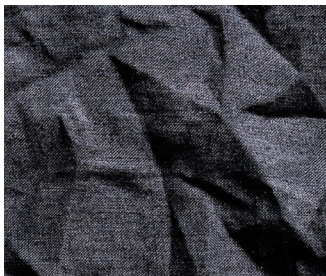
HOLY WEEK WORSHIP

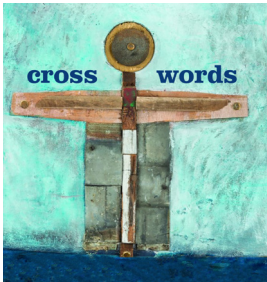
